What did he want? - Would you mind telling me? Whose car was it? - Could you let me know? Is this the right train? - Do you have any idea the right train? When will they get married? - I wonder How long has she known him? - I'd like to know him. Could you babysit tonight? - I was wondering tonight. What is her name? - Can you tell me? Do they have any free tickets? - Could you let me know some free tickets? Where were the boxes? - Can you remember? Which countries did she visit? - Do you know?
