Exercise 2: 14 points

(2 points for each sentence = 1 point for each part)

If he had had money, he would have bought the house.
Provided I knew her number, I could call her.
If I hadn't enjoyed it, I wouldn't have stayed till the end.
I wouldn't have agreed in case it hadn't been a good offer.
If he was/were from here, he wouldn't get lost.
If I had liked the film, I would have watched it.
If he was/were a good actor, he would get the part.

Exercise 3: 14 points

(2 points for each sentence = 1 point for each part)

She won't come unless you tell her.
If you give him a present, he will be surprised.
If you take it, you won't regret it.
In case it rains, I will take my umbrella.
We will miss the plane if we don't set off early.
You wouldn't have crashed if you hadn't driven too fast.
He wouldn't have had a headache in case he would have taken an aspirin.
