Had you be there before? - Yes, the previous year.	<u>Had you been</u>
Did you liked the article in the magazine?	<u>Did you like</u>
I recognized him because I did see him before.	<u>had seen</u>
I hadn't gone out because I hadn't finished my homework.	<u>didn't go out</u>
We had done nothing like this at that time.	We <u>did</u>
It was quite difficult. I had had no idea what to do.	I <u>had</u> no idea
As far as I'd known she had always had some pets.	I <u>knew</u>
When I met Jim he was already a soldier for three years.	he <u>had already been</u>
He had gone to the office because somebody had told him.	He <u>went</u>
