I don't know his address. I can't contact him.

If I knew his address, I could contact him.

He is ill. He can't go skiing.

If he wasn't ill, he could go skiing.

He doesn't like tomatoes. He won't eat the salad.

If he liked tomatoes, he would eat the salad.

I travel on my own because I speak English.

I wouldn't travel on my own if I didn't speak English.

We don't have enough room in our house. You can't stay with us.

If we <u>had</u> enough room in our house, you could stay with us.

You aren't lucky. You won't win.

If you were lucky, you would win.

I go to bed early because I work so hard.

I wouldn't go to bed early if I <u>didn't work</u> so hard.

I am eighteen. I can vote.

If I wasn't | weren't eighteen, I couldn't vote.

Go to Corfu. You may like it.

If you went to Corfu, you might like it.

You'll manage it. Don't panic.

You would manage it if you didn't panic.
