You were not prepared. You could not pass the exam. If you had been prepared, you <u>could have passed</u> the exam.

I came back home late because I had worked long hours. I would not have come back home late if I had not worked long hours.

I was so young. I had no experience. If I had not been so young, I would have had some experience.

They did not go on holiday. They did not have any rest. If they had gone on holiday, they would have had some rest.

You did not know what to do because you had not listened to me. You would have known what to do if you <u>had listened</u> to me.
