My sister didn't want to marry Jim. If he had proposed to her, she would refuse. would have refused

We couldn't buy the house. But we would have done it if we had enough money. had had

I didn't catch a word.. If I had understood, I'd give them some advice. would have given

If he wasn't the best player in the team, he wouldn't have earned so much. hadn't been

Peter was furious. He wouldn't lose his temper if he hadn't done all the work on his own. wouldn't have lost

The kitten didn't want to leave the house. Otherwise it would have played in the garden if it didn't rain cats and dogs. hadn't rained

I didn't know that he was at home. I would drop in if I had known it. would have dropped

They wouldn't have travelled by ship if the authorities didn't close the airport on the island. hadn't closed

She was so pretty. If I were twenty years younger, I would have asked her to marry me. had been
