Make the policeman's questions. _____

Policeman: What yesterday at 8 o'clock? (do)

James: I was driving to work.

Policeman: What time the dog? (meet)

James: I saw him at about 8.30.

Policeman: fast when you saw the dog? (drive)

James: No, I wasn't.

Policeman: What when you stopped your car? (the dog/do)

James: He was sitting in the middle of the road.

Policeman: What after that? (the dog/do)

James: He ran away.

Policeman: How the two girls? (find)

James: I followed the dog, when he came back.

Policeman: when you found them? (the girls/bleed)

James: Yes, they were. They were lying on the grass.

Policeman: anyone else? (see)

James: No, I didn't.

Policeman: an ambulance? (call)

James: No, I didn't. I drove the girls to the hospital.
