Sue: No, they don't. They are two years older. But they meet for lunch.

Ann: Does Mark eat at a school canteen?

Sue: Yes, because our mum and dad don't have the time to prepare his lunch.

Ann: Do your parents go to work?

Sue: Yes, they do. My mum is a nurse and my dad is a doctor.

Ann: Do they work at a hospital?

Sue: Only my mum.

Ann: Does your brother want to be a doctor?

Sue: I don't know. But I want to be a nurse.
