Why don't you (do you not) read such magazines?

I'm doing housework at the moment.

I'm not (I am not) doing housework at the moment.

We go swimming on Tuesdays.

We don't (do not) go swimming on Tuesdays.

My Spanish penfriend sends me postcards.

My Spanish penfriend doesn't (does not) send me postcards.

Why are you listening to us?

Why aren't you (are you not) listening to us?

What does Jack do?

What doesn't Jack (does Jack not) do?

She's sitting over there.

She's not (isn't) (is not) sitting over there.

They have a house in the mountains.

They don't have (do not have) (haven't) (have not) a house in the mountains.

We're having fun.

We're not (aren't) (are not) having fun.
