Is your best friend sitting next to you?

My best friend isn't (is not) sitting next to me.

Does your father get up at 9 every day?

My father doesn't (does not) get up at 9 every day.

Are you drinking milk right now?

I'm not (I am not) drinking milk right now.

Are your parents still sleeping?

My parents aren't (are not) sleeping anymore.

Does your neighbour love you?

My neighbour doesn't (does not) love me.

Do your friends play cricket on Fridays?

My friends don't (do not) play cricket on Fridays.

Does your mother come from Brixham?

My mother doesn't (does not) come from Brixham.

Is your partner watching you at the moment?

My partner isn't (is not) watching me at the moment.

Am I writing this test with you?

You aren't (are not) writing this test with me.

Do all people in your country speak English?

All people in my country don't (do not) speak English.
